Part 01

The Importance of Covenant

GENESIS 17:1-2

1 When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the Lord appeared to Abram and said to him, “I am Almighty God; walk before Me and be blameless. 2 And I will make My covenant between Me and you, and will multiply you exceedingly.”

A covenant is a binding agreement between two parties. Each party agrees to do something for the other party so there is a mutual giving and receiving. However, when God makes a covenant He takes it beyond a mere legal agreement. God’s covenants include a relational component where He invites the other party to enter into a special relationship with Him.

God established the marriage covenant between a man and a woman as a sign of the covenant He desires to have with all of us. Jesus even called the church His bride. In the same way the covenant between a husband and a wife is about mutual love and commitment, God desires to share mutual love and commitment with us.

Our Covenant With You

Covenants are not just between God and man, but can be between any two parties. At Lineage, we desire to enter into a covenant relationship with everyone who calls this place their spiritual home. We call this membership.

As a community of believers who follow Jesus and desire to become more like Him every day, we want to have the same spirit of love and commitment towards one another that God has with us individually. God has given us the example of what intimate relationship looks like in His kingdom and we want to be a reflection of His kingdom here on earth in how we love one another.

Entering into membership with Lineage is a mutual loving commitment between the church leadership and you. It is also a commitment between every member. It is declaring I have your back and I know you have mine.

There is safety and identity within this kind of relationship. It is how a tribe is formed, where every member is fully committed to the prosperity and protection of the tribe as a whole but also to each individual member of the tribe. It is the essence of family.

Like God's covenant with Abraham, membership at Lineage is a mutual sharing of responsibilities from both parties. Check out the diagram below and see what is expected of both parties in our church covenant.

GENESIS 15:7

7 And he said to him, “I am the Lord who brought you out from Ur of the Chaldeans to give you this land to possess.”

Before entering into covenant relationship with Abraham, God wanted to remind him of their history together. God wanted him to be fully aware of their current relationship before moving on to the next level.

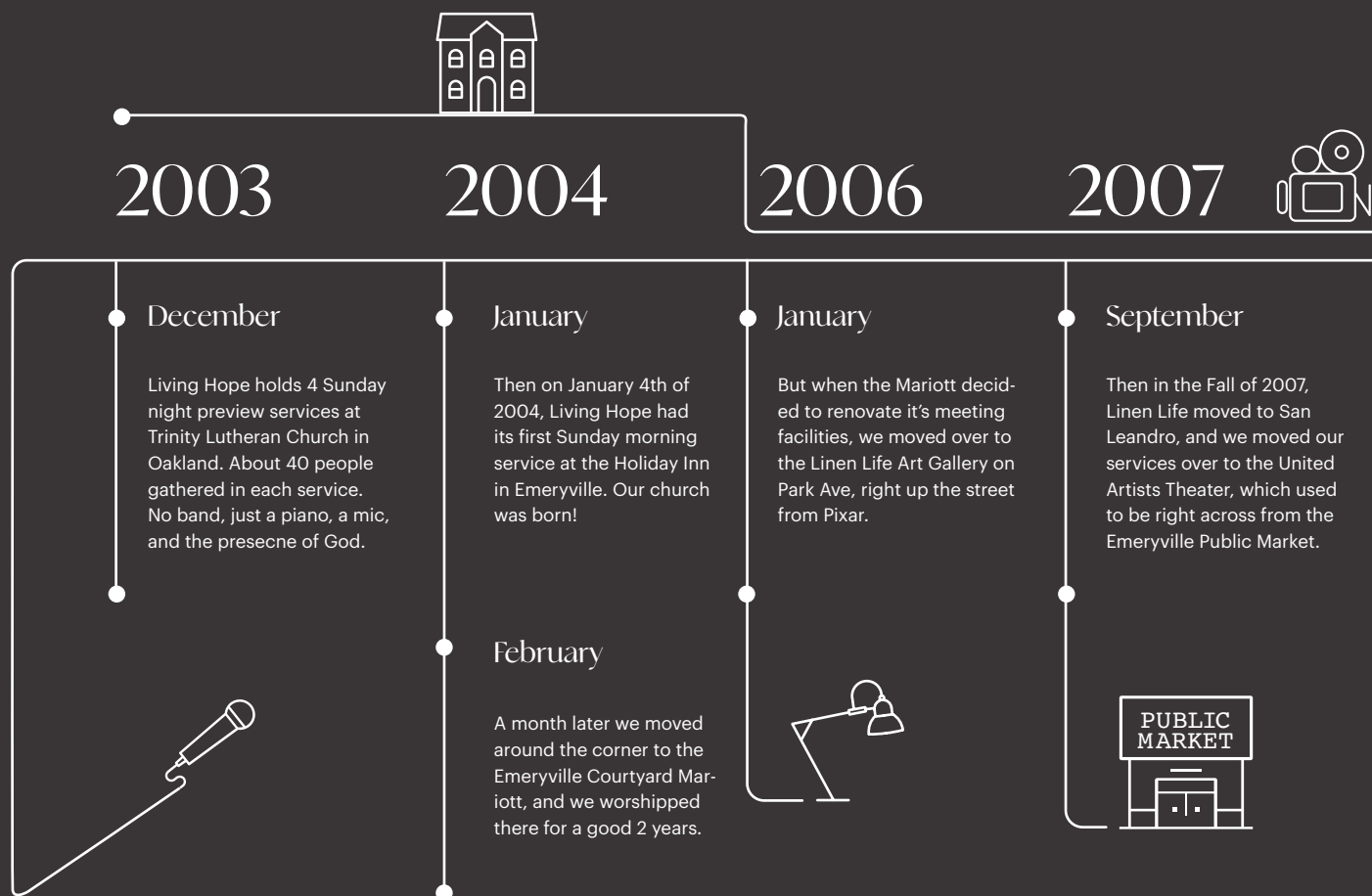

April

After a year and a half at the theater, we were able to secure a small space at 4550 San Pablo Ave in a dairy factory that was converted into an office building. We were there for nearly 7 years.



January

When our lease ended there, we returned to the site of the old Holiday Inn, which had now become the Emeryville Hilton Garden Inn. We spent a year here worshipping on the top floor, enjoying panoramic views of the bay.

November

Towards the end of our time here, we launched our San Francisco campus (SoDa) at the Verdi club in San Francisco's Potrero Hill area.

January

Then, 2 months later our Emeryville campus moved from the Hilton Garden Inn to the Emeryville Center of Community life, and we've been meeting there for the past 3 years.

January

Joined FMC - After being a nondenominational church since our founding, God opened the door for us to join the Free Methodist denomination. An unexpected twist - in the process of joining FMC, we were given a building in El Cerrito - our first permanent location. (Go here for more information!)

Fall

Kingdom first- Finally having our own building, it was time to make it new. As a house, we came together, and in faith, pledged to give \$1.5 million to renovate our new home.

Lineage - Not only did we feel God call us to move with Him, we felt his invitation to become more fully who we were meant to be. In November, we rebranded from Living Hope Christian Center to Lineage Church.

Part 03

Who We Are & What We Believe

GENESIS 15:6

6 And he believed the Lord, and He counted it to him as righteousness.

God and Abraham have a beautiful story and a relationship that grew over time. God first appeared to Abraham in Genesis 12, but He did not bring up the idea of covenant relationship until chapters 15 and 17. When God first introduced Himself to Abraham, He asked him to leave his home country and go to a foreign place because He wanted to bless him.

God waited until Abraham had gone through some experiences with Him and built trust in Him. God waited until Abraham knew Him better because covenant relationship is a committed relationship that requires trust. God did not expect Abraham to trust Him without knowing Him.

In the same way, it is important for you to know who we are as Lineage and what we believe. We want you to get to know us and understand exactly what kind of church community we are before you decide to become a member and join us. There are four central parts to our identity as a church: vision, mission, values, and statement of faith.

VISION

God Truly Among Us

Every human heart longs for God. This is the foundation of everything we do. Our vision is the real God coming to satisfy the real longing of every human heart.

MISSION

Becoming More Fully Who We Are As We Discover More Fully Who He Is

If we seek God, we will find him. The problem is that we tend to seek everything but God and therefore satisfy every need but our deepest need. Our mission is to teach multitudes of people to turn away from false longings and pursue the fulfillment of their true longing: God.

CORE VALUES

Identity ——— Your true identity is found only in God!

Community ——— Commitment to community is the only path toward fullness in Christ!

Maturity ——— God has more for you than you could ever imagine!

Freedom ——— There is no brokenness that cannot be mended or chain that cannot be broken in this way!

Statement of Faith

GOD

God has many roles and functions (like Creator, King, and Judge), but his identity is Father. He created us because he had a surplus of love that demanded an object, and each of us has been uniquely created to be an object of a unique expression of his love.

JESUS

Because we all have rebelled against God and therefore live as orphans, even though he created us to be sons and daughters, God sent his son Jesus to take the punishment for our sin and invite us back home, to God's house. We accept that invitation by believing that Jesus is God's son, that he took the punishment for our sin by dying on the cross, and that God raised him from the dead on the third day. As we believe this in our hearts and confess this with our mouths, we may trust Jesus for our salvation and be "born again," brought back into right relationship with God as his sons and daughters.

THE HOLY SPIRIT

When God brings us back into his family as his sons and daughters, he doesn't just adopt us; he gives us his DNA. The Holy Spirit is the DNA of God. He comes to dwell inside of us when we truly believe in Jesus, and he opens our eyes and our hearts so that we can hear God, see God, feel God, and know God's love to the fullest! As we walk with Jesus, we should ask God for more and more of the Holy Spirit so that we can grow closer and closer to God for the rest of our lives.

THE CHURCH

The church is not an institution, a club, or a political affiliation. The church is God's family, and it is composed of his sons and daughters who come to know one another as brothers and sisters. The true experience of community in the church should not be built around our common earthly interests or pursuits, but around our shared passion for knowing Jesus, being filled with his Spirit, walking in his freedom, and reflecting his glory to every creature under heaven!

THE BIBLE

We believe the bible to be the authoritative witness to the person and work of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. Because we are committed to believing and serving the Jesus revealed in Scripture, we are also committed to believing and teaching only what is expressly taught in Scripture.

Part 04

The Blessing of Covenant

GENESIS 12:2-3

2 And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. 3 I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.

GENESIS 15:5

5 And he brought him outside and said, "Look toward heaven, and number the stars, if you are able to number them." Then he said to him, "So shall your offspring be."

God invited Abraham into a covenant relationship to be with him but God had two other powerful purposes as well. God wanted to bless Abraham personally, not just for his own prosperity, but so that all nations would be blessed as well.

God did this in two steps. He first told Abraham his vision of what he wanted to do for him and what he wanted to do on the earth (Genesis 12). Then, God brought Abraham outside and had him look at the stars. God invited Abraham to dream with Him what that might look like in his life and in the lives of those around him. We want to do the same with you!

We believe this is the same spirit found in membership at Lineage. Entering into membership with us both blesses you personally but also blesses the world around us as you join us in spreading the kingdom of God on earth.

Go back to Chapter 1 and review Lineage's responsibility to its members. This is how we want to bless our members! Then, go back to Chapter 3 and read our vision and mission statements. This is how we want to bless the world around us!

Go Deeper

9 And God said to Abraham, 'As for you, you shall keep my covenant, you and your offspring after you throughout their generations.'

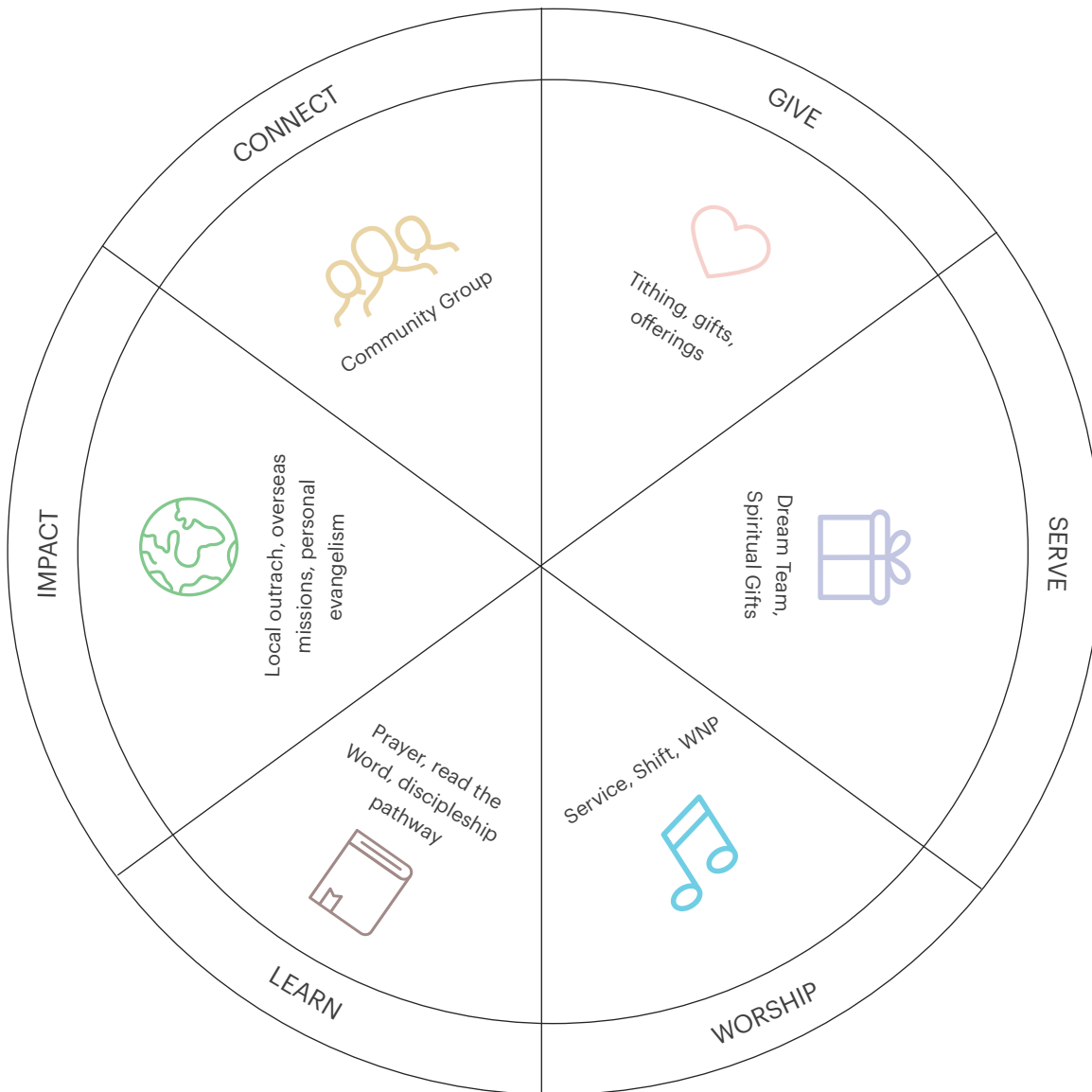
